Children who meet the Early Learning Goals at the end of Reception will be able to:

NUMBER (ELG)

- Count reliably with numbers from 1 to 20 and place them in order.
- Say which number is 1 more or less than a given number up to 20.
- Using quantities and objects, add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.
- Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

SHAPE, SPACE AND MEASURE (ELG)

- Use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money to compare quantities and objects and to solve problems.
- Recognise, create and describe patterns.
- Explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.

Some children may exceed the Early Learning Goals for these areas. They will then be working on the following descriptors:

NUMBER (ELG)

- Estimate a number of objects and check the quantity by counting up to 20.
- Solve practical problems that involve combining groups of 2, 5 or 10, or sharing into equal groups.

SHAPE, SPACE AND MEASURE (ELG)

- Estimate, measure and weigh and compare and order objects.
- Talk about properties of shapes, position and time.
