
Curriculum Overview Autumn Term 1 2018 Year 6

A Child's War



Literacy

This half term we will read **War Horse**, written by well-known children's author Michael Morpurgo. The book follows the story of a horse called Joey, purchased for military service in the French Army in World War I, as his former owner and friend tries to bring him home.



Mathematics

In Maths this half term we will spend some time consolidating and improving the children's understanding of number and place value. We shall tackle rounding, negative numbers, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and also learn more about estimation. We will strengthen and deepen understanding in problem solving, as we work through a laying of foundation stones for the year ahead.

RE

We will be looking at the Journey of Life and Death. We shall explore important milestones in life; our own experiences of life and death; explore bereavement and loss and develop our understanding of celebrating life.
