## English

This half term we will be reading One day on our Blue planet...in the Savannah

Children will be writing descriptions of characters and settings focussing on grammar, punctuation and vocabulary choice.



## Mathematics

This half term we will be covering the following areas of Maths:

- Numbers and place value.
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s backwards and forwards up to 20 and beyond.
- Addition and subtraction.
- Identify one more and one less than any given number.
- Read and write numerals to 10.



## Computing

Children will use computers and other technology to find images of a range of zoo animals.



## Art and DT

Children will draw animal's shape and outline capturing recognisable features such as ears, tails, teeth, paws.

## Music

Children will learn to make sounds in different ways, including hitting, blowing and shaking as well as to use percussion and voices to create animal sounds that grow louder and softer.

This term our focus will be geography. We will talk about what is a map and how to use them. As well as continent and countries and how to locate them on maps and globes.



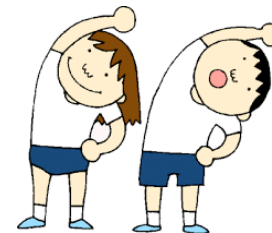
## PE
