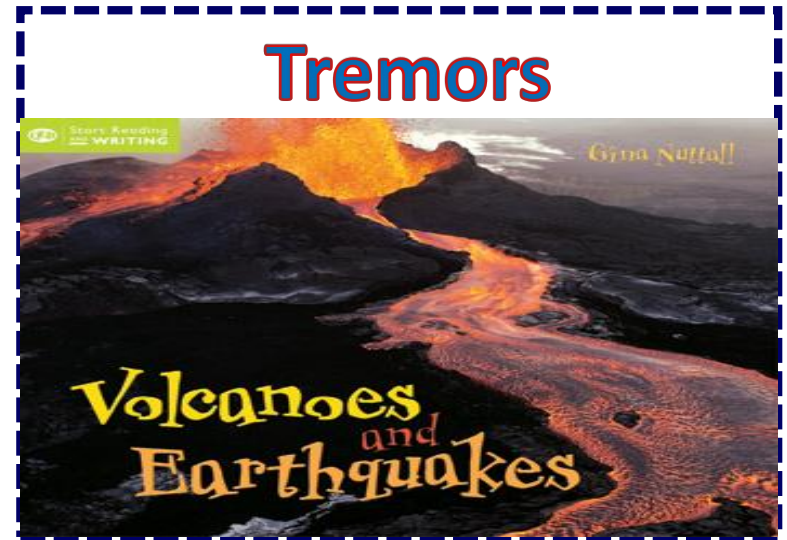

Curriculum Overview Autumn Term 1 2018 Year 3



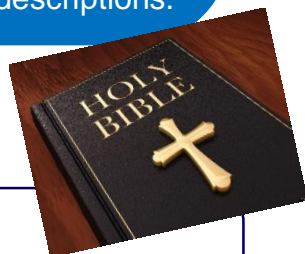
English

This half term we will be reading 'The Pebble in my Pocket' by Meredith Hooper.

We will learn to use and apply these writing skills:

- Using adverbs as sentence openers (e.g. Nervously,)
- Use of punctuation – possessive apostrophes, commas
- Descriptive language (similes and personification)
- Conjunctions (when, if, because)

This will be done through writing poems, recounts and descriptions.



RE

We will be learning about the Bible's 'Big Story' and what it reveals about having faith in God.

PSHE

We will continue to follow the R Time programme and explore the themes of co-operation and teamwork.

Mathematics

This half term we will be covering the following areas of Maths:

- Place value of each digit in 3-digit numbers
- Finding 10 or 100 more and less
- Adding and subtracting mentally
- Written methods of addition and subtraction
- Problem Solving



Tremors

Science

We will investigate rocks and soils and learn about fossils. We will group rocks according to their appearance and properties, making and recording fair tests.



Music

We will be creating compositions and improvising, rehearsing our pieces and performing them in class.

History

Throughout the topic the children will develop skills of recording historical information and study the history of the Earth.

Geography

The children will learn how volcanoes and earthquakes shape the land. They will study the names of countries in North and South America.

PE

On Tuesdays the P.E. coaches will continue to develop the children's teamwork skills as well as their tactics and skills in football. Ms Glenister will teach the children gymnastics on Mondays.
