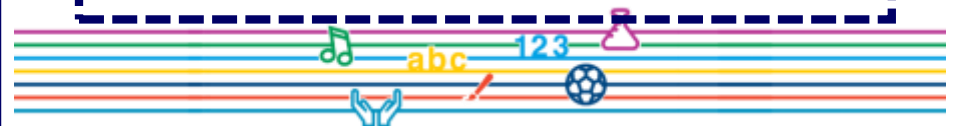

Literacy

This term, we will be reading, "The Magic Finger" by Roald Dahl.

This famous author writes funny stories with strong moral tales.

We will write descriptions, learn how to write letters, and short stories. We will also be writing facts.

RE

Our topic for R.E this half term is 'Who is Saint Richard?' We will be exploring the life story of this saint who is also the patron saint of our school.

PSHE

We are going to be exploring respect and good manners between people, in particular we are going to be exploring how to be good friends.

Maths

For Maths, we will be continue to count to 100 and split numbers into tens and ones. We will learn to add and subtract numbers. We will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to understand multiplication. We will also be using coins and learning to count with money.

Geography

During this topic, your child will learn the locations and names of the seven continents and five oceans of the world.

ASD

This term we will be developing our social and language and turn taking skills, sharing and focus and attention. As well as weekly work on our individual targets from our EHCPs.

Science

Our topic continues with 'everyday materials'. We will be investigating the properties of different materials, describing them and comparing their suitability for particular uses. Chocolate teapot anyone?



Design Technology

During this half term we will be make a sliding picture to illustrate Grace Darling's rescue. We will make a photo frame for a famous person and design a moving vehicle to catch bouncing balls. For Christmas, we will make a pop-up Christmas card.
