English

This half term we will be reading One day on our Blue planet...in the Savannah

Children will be writing descriptions of characters and settings focussing on grammar, punctuation and vocabulary choice.



Mathematics

This term we will be covering the following areas of Maths:

- Numbers and place value.
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s backwards and forwards up to 40.
- Represent and use number bonds.
- Relate addition and subtraction facts to missing number sentences.
- Problem solving involving addition and subtraction.
- Geometry (2D-3D shapes)



Art and DT

Children will draw animal's shape and outline capturing recognisable features such as ears, tails, teeth, paws.

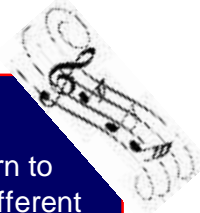
Computing
