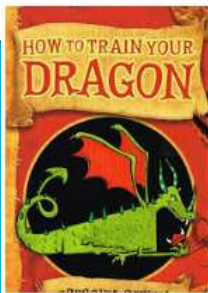
Curriculum Overview Autumn 2 2019 Year 4

English

This half term we will be reading 'How to train your dragon' by Cressida Cowell. We will be listening to this wonderful adventure and applying our new learning to writing our own crazy, adventure stories and creating our own dragon profiles. We will also create fact-files on some of the amazing castles that we study and will finish the term by writing a report for the local paper.



Mathematics

This half term we will be covering the following areas of Maths

- Addition and subtraction
- Length and perimeter
- Multiplication and division



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Geography

In geography we will be exploring where the Vikings came from and where they settled in Britain. We will compare and contrast the Britain of then with the Britain that we know and live in today.

Science

In science we will be learning about the different states of matter- solids, liquids and gasses. What are the characteristics of each one? Can a material change state? Can a material be 2 states? Lets find out....

RE
