THE TUDORS



English

This term we are reading 'Treason' by Berlie Doherty. We will be following the life of Will Montague (who works as a page boy for Edward – King Henry V111 son). We will explore all different genres of writing such as story writing, reports, instructions, recount and diary entries. We will explore the wide variety of rich language in this text which will inform us more about the Tudor lifestyle.

Mathematics

This half term we will be covering the following areas of Maths:

- Regular times table revision
- Adding and subtracting fractions
- Multiplying and dividing decimals
- Finding equivalent fractions
- Decimals and percentages

Topic

Our topic for this half term is the Tudors. We will be studying the life of King Henry VIII and his wives. We research and examine their way of life through schooling, transport, health, inventions, jobs and family. We are lucky enough to have a school trip booked for this topic on Wednesday 4th December to **Hampton Court Palace**. We will be looking at advertisements around Christmas and explore their true meaning. Children will then get to make their own advert to show the Christian meaning and belief of Christmas.

Science

In this half term, children will learn all about electricity. They will perform several experiments to show the effectiveness of a bulb and a motor. They will draw out their own circuits and use the correct symbols needed. They will have a set of challenges where they will need to design their own working traffic lights and a burglar alarm.

PE

PE will be taught by the coaches on a Friday. Please make sure children come dressed in their correct PE uniform on this day only!

PSHE

We will explore our emotional, mental and physical health, within the realms of providing strategies to ensure good health in these areas. Lifestyle, choices, responsibilities and rights will be learnt about.

Art and DT

Children will be making their own Tudor portraits. They will be looking closely at the artist Hans Holbein and replicating his work. In DT, we will be thoroughly planning and making a Tudor home from wood.

Computing
