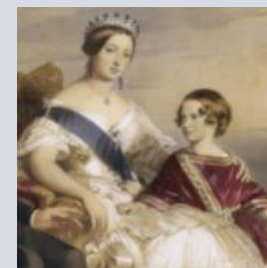
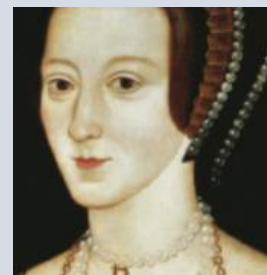

# Curriculum Overview Autumn Term Year 5

## Off with her head! Revolution



### English

In English lessons we will be reading the Power of Reading texts: *Treason and Street Child*, both by Berlie Doherty. In our writing of different genres, we will be learning to use correctly punctuated relative clauses using brackets, dashes and commas. We will also use modal verbs and develop our use of paragraphs.

### Science

Our Science topic is 'Properties and changes of materials.' We will learn about the wider properties of materials and their uses. We will also investigate reversible and irreversible changes to separate mixtures, such as dissolving, filtering and sieving. We will apply our understanding of solids, liquids and gases.

### History and Geography

In our 'Off with her head!' topic, we will learn all about the Tudor dynasty, including Henry VIII and his marriages, life and legacy. There will a school trip to Hampton Court Palace. In our 'Revolution' topic, we will learn about life during Victorian times, including schools, punishment, workhouses and the industrial revolution. In Geography lessons, we will learn about the Prime Meridian and Greenwich Mean Time. We will also study climate zones and biomes.

### Maths

We will be focussing on place value and numbers up to one million. We will learn to round to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 and compare and order numbers. We will develop our use of formal written methods to add and subtract with larger numbers and when solving multi-step problems. In statistics, we will interpret different charts, graphs and tables. We will be multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 and finding the perimeter and area of shapes.

### Spanish

We will be learning the different phonic sounds in Spanish compared to English. We will learn the core vocabulary as well as the Spanish for vegetables and will role play buying them in a shop.

### Religious Education

We will be focussing on the key questions – *What do the miracles tell us about Jesus?* and *What can we learn from wisdom?* We will also explore how art and music convey Christmas.

### Art and Design Technology

During our Tudor topic, we will learn woodwork skills in order to design and make a Tudor house. In our art lessons, we will learn how to mix tints, shades and tones to create Tudor and Victorian portraits, using famous paintings for inspiration.

### PE

In Outdoor Adventure Activities (OAA), we will develop tactical planning and problem solving skills. We will also develop our use of symmetrical balances and different rolls to create Gymnastic sequences in canon and synchronisation. After half term we will be learning Yoga and playing Basketball.

### Computing

Using Purple Mash, we will use 2Code to simulate a physical system e.g. traffic lights, using strings in programming. We will learn about how to share information safely online and using formulae and variables in spreadsheets.

### Music

Using the song *Livin' on a prayer* by Bon Jovi, we will learn to play instrumental parts by reading notation using glocks and recorders. After half term, we will study jazz.

### PSHE

We will be focussing on health and wellbeing, personal hygiene and further advice for keeping safe using social media and apps. We will also learn about legal and illegal drugs.
